

# Coming Soon: Virginia Transcript Center

The **Virginia Transcript Center (VTC)** is under construction. Using SIF, VTC will facilitate the exchange of eTranscripts to colleges and universities, and student record exchange between VA school divisions.

The VDOE and its partners, Pearson, Edustructures, and the National Transcript Center are engaged with ten school divisions and two institutions of higher education to pilot eTranscripts. It is scheduled to be completed by June '08.

## What does VTC mean to me?

- ▶ VTC will be the common hub used for exchanging student records with other VA school divisions and transcripts with higher education.
  - Ability to send electronic transcripts for many students to a single institution in three steps
  - Ability to send an electronic transcript for a single student to many institutions in three steps

## How will I benefit from VTC?

- ▶ Save time – send a student record in seconds!
- ▶ Use one system to send student records to other VA school divisions and higher education.
- ▶ Improve student placement by receiving records of transfer students the same day.
- ▶ Save money through reduced staff time and elimination of materials and postage costs.
- ▶ Reduce fraudulent transcripts.

## Tell me more about VTC!

- ▶ The web interface is user-friendly and intuitive.
- ▶ There's no software to maintain or install.
- ▶ VTC uses 128-bit SSL encryption and online security measures like those used by online banking.

## What do I need to do?

- ▶ Nothing...just stay tuned for more information about the pilot and plans for a general rollout after June 2008.
- ▶ We will most likely be piloting the division to division student record exchange, so stay tuned to that news, as well.
