The **National Transcript Center** is a secure national service that improves the efficiency, reliability, cost and security of sending and receiving student transcripts. NTC member institutions log in to a user-friendly, browser-based application to *send, receive, manage, track, and import* their electronic transcripts. NTC currently has seven statewide contracts with PK-12 state education agencies: California, Colorado, Connecticut, Texas, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wyoming.

NTC Standard Membership:

- ▶ [NTC Standard Membership](#) provides a connection to NTC within two business days without any technical work on your part. NTC's simple web interface allows you to exchange transcripts as PDFs with schools across the country. You'll be able to receive transcripts electronically from any NTC member and send them to any academic institution in the country – whether or not the recipient is a member of NTC. You can also request transcripts from any school in the country, track your transcripts and requests, deliver transcripts securely to any email address, and more!

Only care about [receiving transcripts](#)? NTC Standard Membership is perfect for you! Inbound transcript layouts are standardized, so they're easier for you to process. And, if you don't send any transcripts, we just won't bill you for that.

NTC Premium Membership:

- ▶ [NTC Premium Membership](#) provides all of the above features but also allows you to exchange transcript data in PESC XML or SPEEDE EDI formats. Transcripts you send are translated into the recipient's preferred data format and delivered electronically – or, if the recipient isn't prepared to receive electronic transcripts, printed on secure transcript paper and mailed. Transcripts you receive may be viewed as PDFs and/or downloaded in your preferred data format for import into your student information system.

Pricing: \$5 to send a transcript. Free to request and receive transcripts. Set-up and annual fees depend on the type of membership and the size of the institution – and may be waived by a statewide contract. Call (512) 879-5400 for details.
